

# Supplying - Selling Eggs for Resale

## At a Licensed Establishment

- 1) Inspection by ODA at the farm, in order to be registered with ODA as a “Small Egg Producer” You should get an “Certificate of Registration” from ODA; *you will need to show the certificate to the licensed establishment, they will need to make a copy of the certificate to have on file at their location. The Ashland County-City Health Dept. (ACCHD) will want to see the copy of the certificate at the establishment, to prove that the establishment is getting eggs from an “Approved Source”.*
- 2) Eggs must be properly labeled per ODA requirements with:
  - Count (number of eggs in carton)
  - Ungraded/Mixed size eggs
  - Your Name (as producer)
  - Your Address (road or street and town)
  - Date eggs packed into carton
  - Safe handling instructions
- 3) Eggs must be held on farm under mechanical refrigeration at 45 degrees Fahrenheit, or below. (this is an ODA requirement)
- 4) *Eggs must be transported at 45 degrees Fahrenheit, or below, until they are received by the licensed establishment.*  
*(per OUFSC, 3717-1-03.4, (F), (2), OAC)*  
*(An ice chest or cooler with ice is an acceptable means of transport)*

**Safe Handling Instructions**

To prevent illness from bacteria: Keep eggs refrigerated, cook eggs until yolks are firm, and cook foods containing eggs thoroughly.
