Powdered Infant Formula Voluntarily Recalled

ASHLAND, OH - Abbott is voluntarily recalling three of their powdered infant formulas for a possible link to bacterial infections in infants. The voluntary recall includes Similac, Alimentum and EleCare formulas that were manufactured at the Sturgis, Michigan facility, with expiration dates of April 1, 2022, or later.

This recall does not include any of the metabolic deficiency nutrition formulas. No Abbott liquid formulas, powder formulas, or nutrition products from other facilities are impacted by the recall.

Symptoms of Cronobacter sakazakii or Salmonella Newport can include fever, poor feeding, excessive crying or low energy as well as other serious symptoms.

The products under recall have a multidigit number on the bottom of the container starting with the first two digits 22 through 37, contains K8, SH, or Z2 and with an expiration date of April 1, 2022, or after.
